Text Introduction

"Let's read the title of this book together: *The Big Game*. In this book, Kim is playing baseball. She hits the ball and has to run to the base without the other players tagging her.

"Say stumble. Stumble means when you trip and sometimes fall. In this book one of the characters stumbles. Read to find out who it is."

Discussion

- "What happened at the end of this book?"
- "Who stumbled in this book?"
- "How did the people in the stands feel at the end of the book? How do you know?"
