Additional Notes/Tips

- *Beach* is a story word and is not decodable.
- During the phonics warm-up, you may want to define the word *grin* after students decode it.

Text Introduction

“Let’s read the title of this book together. *A Trip to the Beach*, this book is about Glen and his Gran and their trip to the beach.

“Something *surprising* is going to happen in this book. Say *surprising*. It means when something happens that you weren’t expecting. Read to find out what *surprising* thing happens at the end!”

Discussion

- “What surprising thing happened at the end?”
- “Why didn’t Glen and Gran put the crab in their bag to take home?”
- “How do you think Glen felt about looking for shells with Gran? How do you know?”
