### Additional Notes/Tips

- *Pizza* is a story word and is not decodable.
- *Ran* may be tricky for some students to decode—you may help students adjust the /a/ sound.
- During the phonics warm-up segment, you may want to define the words *bin* and *hid* after students decode them.

### Text Introduction

“Let’s read the title of this book together, *Rat Ran*. Look at Rat. What does he have? Yes, Rat has a piece of pizza. In this book, Rat has a piece of pizza and he wants to eat it!

“You’ll see that Rat figures out where to eat his pizza. He does something *clever*. Say clever. Clever means smart, having good ideas. Look for the clever thing Rat does!”

### Discussion

- “Didn’t Rat do something clever? Where did he go to eat his pizza?”
- “How do you think Rat felt when he saw the cat?”
