## Additional Notes/Tips

- \*\**Then* and *that* are decodable, but we recommend drawing attention to them to give children practice with the voiced /th/ sound.
- *Tacos* is a story word and is not decodable.
- If students ask about Rex's wheelchair, you might say, "That's a wheelchair. Rex uses a wheelchair to get around."

## **Text Introduction**

"The title of this book is *Tacos*. In this book, Rex is preparing tacos. Say prepare. When you prepare something, you make it or get it ready.

"Let's read to find out what happens while Rex prepares his tacos."

## Discussion

- "What happened while Rex was preparing his taco?"
- "What were some of the things Rex put in his taco while he was preparing it?"
- "How did Rex solve his little problem at the end?"
