Working With Words

Phonemic Awareness Warm-Up

Blend: blur, car, snore **Segment:** swirl, dark, star

Introduce/Review Target Concept

"Today we will work with all of the sounds and spellings we have learned recently. We have learned about vowels with r next to them, r-controlled vowels. Ready to go?"

Read and Spell Words

High Frequency Words

Guide students to read blending lines.

Teach and/or review the words *many* and *one*.

Define *lurk*: when something scary hides

nearby where you can't see it.

Spell and check: fort, dark, swirl.

Reading the Text

Before Reading: Introduce Text and Key Vocabulary

"Read the title of this book—Jade in the Dark. In this book, Jade, Jon, and Kit's moms take them on a camping trip. At first Jade has a lot of fun, but when it gets dark she starts to get anxious. Say anxious. Anxious means nervous about something that might happen. Read to find out how Jade deals with feeling anxious in the dark."

After Reading: Discuss

- "How did Jade's feelings change across the book?"
- "Why does Jade feel less anxious at the end?"
