

# The Crab Boil (AV A)

Target Phonics: oi, oy: /oi/

## Working With Words

Phonemic Awareness Warm-Up	
<b>Blend:</b> boil, joy, moist	<b>Segment:</b> join, point, boy
Introduce/Review Target Concept	
<p>“Did you hear the /oi/ sound in all of those words? Today we will study two patterns that spell the /oi/ sound. Oi stands for the sound /oi/, like in the word <i>coin</i>. Oi usually comes at the middle of the word. Oy also stands for the sound /oi/, like in the word <i>toy</i>. Oy comes at the end of words. The /oi/ sound is called a diphthong because our mouth moves a little like it is making two sounds!”</p>	
Read and Spell Words	High Frequency Words
Guide students to read blending lines. Define <i>moist</i> : not dry. Spell and check: boil, join, boy.	No new high frequency words in this book. Review any HFW students may be unfamiliar with.

## Reading the Text

Before Reading: Introduce Text and Key Vocabulary
<p>“Read the title of this book—<i>The Crab Boil</i>. Have you ever heard of a crab boil? A crab boil is a special kind of meal where people cook up crabs with lots of spices and vegetables like corn and potatoes. In this book, Rex and Jai go to a crab boil. Say <i>demonstrate</i>. <i>Demonstrate</i> means to show someone how to do something. Read to find out what Rex’s Gramps has to demonstrate for Rex and Jai at the crab boil.”</p>
After Reading: Discuss
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• “What did Gramps have to demonstrate?”</li><li>• “How did Jai feel at the beginning of the story? How did his feelings change by the end?”</li></ul>
